



Impact Thrift Stores Fact Sheet

Impact Thrift Stores, co-founded by Paul Baur, was started in the spring of 2001. Impact Thrift is an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that supports locally based charities with net proceeds from its store operations and recycling programs. Impact Thrift is governed by a Board of Directors with the day-to-day operations overseen by CEO & President, Gray Wirth.

Charities

Impact Thrift Stores has donated over 2 million dollars to over 16 different locally-based charities since 2003. Impact Thrift also partners with many other organizations that assist those who find themselves in a time of need.

Stores

The first store opened in December of 2001 at 14 East Moreland Avenue in Hatboro, PA - the former location of Santerians Department store.

Impact Thrift opened its second location November of 2002 at 325 West Main Street in Lansdale, PA. In August of 2009, the Lansdale store was relocated to 979 Bethlehem Pike (Route 309), Montgomeryville, PA.

Impact Thrift opened its third location in July of 2004 at 57 East Germantown Pike, East Norriton, PA. In November of 2008, the East Norriton store was relocated to 1798 Markley Street, Norristown, PA.

Impact Thrift's fourth store opened in April 2012 at 91 East Street Road in Feasterville, PA. The Feasterville store is the largest to date, offering 48,000 sq. ft. of retail space.

In August of 2015, Impact Thrift Stores opened it's 5th location, a clothing-only Fashion OUTLET in Bristol, PA.

Merchandise

Impact Thrift Stores receives its merchandise from the local community as donations. In exchange for their gently-used merchandise, donors receive a signed and dated tax receipt, as well as the gratification of knowing that their things will be repurposed (sold to others) and proceeds will go to locally based charities. Donations can be dropped off at any of our stores, or a free pick up can be scheduled for larger items by calling 215.957.6131.

Impact Thrift Stores sell: clothing, furniture, knick-knacks, books, household and kitchen items, appliances, sporting goods, jewelry, electronics, and more.

Community Service Programs

Impact Thrift Stores partners with Montgomery County Probation, Bucks County Probation and the Youth Aid Panel for those needing to perform mandatory community service hours. For more information on these programs, contact the manager of an Impact Thrift Store near you.

Recycling

Impact Thrift currently recycles over 4 million pounds of clothing/textiles and electronics/metals each year. In addition, over 1.5 million pounds of books, plastics, paper and other items have been diverted from landfills since 2012.

Employment

Impact Thrift currently employs over 200 people, as well as volunteers and community service personnel.
